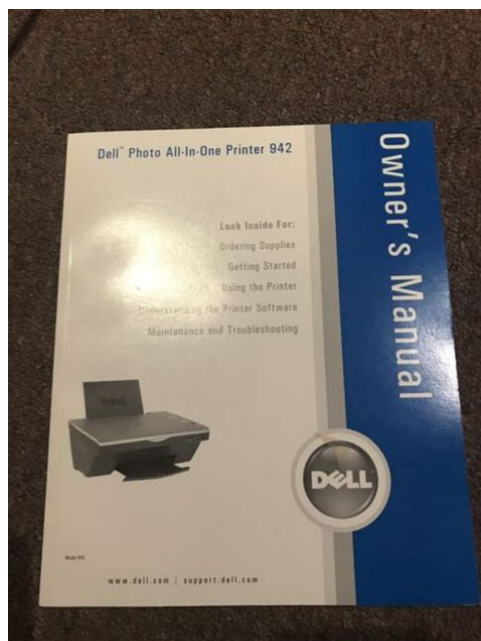

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Dell Photo All-In-One Printer 942 Manual

Because the Dell 942 holds only two cartridges at a time, youll become intimately familiar and probably annoyed with swapping inks when you want to print photos and text in rapid succession. A sensor conveniently distinguishes between plain, coated, or glossy paper and transparencies and adjusts the settings to match; but you can override those settings if you wish. With its LCD, fullfeatured control panel, and builtin scanner, the Dell 942 allinone photo printer can do a lot without your computer. You can slap a document on the glass bed and punch a button for standalone color or black copies. And by scrolling down the LCD menu, you can tweak photocopy quality, squeeze an original to print it up to 16 times on a page, and shrink or enlarge copies. The control panel is easy to use, thanks to functionspecific buttons and a fourway rocker button for navigating the menu. This allows you to display and print photo thumbnails; view images as a slide show; or rotate, crop, adjust, and print pictures. But of course, youll have to stop and switch ink if you were just printing a black text document earlier. With 32MB of RAM, the Dell 942 easily zipped through a photo card full of highresolution images in CNET Labs tests. The menus also let you upload photos straight from a memory card to your PC. However, the 942 lacks one common multifunction feature a standalone fax. Using Windows Fax Console software and your PCs fax modem, you could scan a document, convert its format, and send it but thats a lot of work. Still, many multifunctions lack any fax capabilities at all, so this could work for you if you need to fax only once in a while. 0 optical character recognition package, which converts scanned images of text files into text you

can edit on your PC. The printer driver lets you set up duplex jobs and create booklets, reduce and print several pages on one sheet, produce banners, and enlarge a page into a poster. An I Want To menu walks you through printing envelopes and posters. A separate utility, the AllinOne Center, guides you through scans, faxes, and copies by making sure you pick the appropriate resolution, color depth, image cleanup, and so on. If you're new to scanning, the Dell 942 makes it easy. If you don't plan to print much, Dell sells smaller replacement cartridges for a few dollars less. The Dell 942 AllinOne photo printer topped the chart in CNET Labs text printing speed tests, pumping out 7ppm, far ahead of other multifunction printers. It took 4.8 minutes to print a high-resolution 8x10 photo, against the 9.6 minutes spent by the Lexmark X7170. This device also photocopied 3.5ppm, again the fastest we've seen. Throughout our tests, the Dell 942 worked flawlessly overall and exceeded our expectations for a multifunction of its class. This unit was tested with its default settings, which can be adjusted to improve the performance. It was hard to read at the smallest fonts but clear enough to decipher at 3-point size—impressive for an inkjet. Big letters showed choppiness or rough edges, especially inside curves, but text looked even, smooth, and clean. Color prints looked even better than text, with smooth shading transitions, fine detail, and accurate colors. Unfortunately, the document showed graininess throughout. Photographs came out grainy and a bit warm, though dynamic range was decent. We also saw signs of posterization, a banding effect produced by reducing the number of gray tones in an image. And while printing, the 942 also provides a graphical display of the ink levels. Dell includes two flash media slots that read all the major formats except, strangely, xDPicture Cards larger than 512MB. The user can choose the images they want to print by browsing them on the LCD—no need to go to the PC. The 942's index prints are basic grids of images, unlike the attractive layouts from Canon, Epson and HP models that can be used to produce full prints. Thanks to its fast USB 2.0 connection, the 942 quickly uploads images to a PC from a memory card. A PictBridge port allows printing directly from any compatible digital camera. Although the buttons on the control panel look cheap, they're quite efficient to use. There's a mode button to switch between photo, fax, copy and scan tasks, indicated by a set of four LEDs. The 942 doesn't have a built-in fax, but the user can send scanned documents via their PC's fax modem. On plain paper, dithering was visible in photos, and colors—especially skin tones—didn't look realistic. Our text and line art prints looked nice and dark, thanks in part to the pigment black ink. But prints showed excessive narrow horizontal banding, and lettering looked smudged. Text printed at an admirable 7.5 pages per minute, and our test photo printout was complete in 97 seconds, much faster than the average speed of similar MFDs. Colour graphics printed at a below-average 1.4ppm, however. The 942's colour scanning was particularly impressive, reproducing tones faithfully, and extracting plenty of detail. The unit's scan speed was average, but its copy speed of 3.6ppm was significantly better than average. Dell based the 942's software driver on Lexmark's well-designed AllInOne Center, revealing this MFP's origins. The large package of software includes the ABBYY FineReader 5.0 Sprint Plus OCR application for converting scanned documents into editable text. Unfortunately, Dell supplies Jasc's Paint Shop Pro image editor only as a trial version.

Lots of issues with the printer set up. I wound up paying a technician to get the drivers working and the printer set up. This was a huge savings. I had it for 10 years. That's the only reason I ordered another one since I had the cartridges. It was used and advertised as running beautifully and in excellent condition and a great price. Oh well. Live and learn. It works fine, even though it sounds like a construction worker breaking up cement when it prints! Since Dell is not producing them anymore, I checked online and found one new one on Amazon. It has a book that comes with it and is easy to find how to work things not just a CD which I hate am 74 yrs old. The one problem I did have with this order was the ink cartridges had dried out, probably due to sitting waiting for a purchase for a long time.

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Had to buy a black one immediately and I have hardly used the colored, but it is very low. Dell 924 printer is a little better than 926 printer for only photo printing, but only black and white font printing is fair for Dell 924 printer. However, that is canceled out if you dont buy ink from Dell because then the printer does not recognize ink levels at all. Dell laptop for a few years, I don't think I will purchase Dell products anymore. They are great for the first few years, but then don't work as well later. It was easy to assemble a couple of wires and start it up. It prints with many different settings, scans, faxes and copies the way a printer is supposed to. The price is very competitive and I really love the dependability of my printer, which has outlasted my first computer, and is working like a charm for my second Dell, that's about 6 years of lots of usage everyday. You really can't get a better deal. I am an electronics dummie. I am so bad I even had problems operating a simple electric can opener. So when my children all chopped in to purchase me a computer I thought they had totally lost their minds.

But with patience and a lot of mess ups, I conquered the computer. Then on my birthday, they decided to buy me a Dell Personal AllIn One Printer A920. Oh boy, I thought, another confusing electronic. I read the owners manual, which was very easy to understand. I was also surprised that it was also really easy to change the ink cartridges. The fun part of my new printer is the scanner that is built in. That too is so easy to operate. I just put what I want scanned under the lid and I can click preview and see what the final document will look like, and, after approval, click ok and I can save it in my files or print it. So easy, even a dummie like me can do it! More advanced printing jobs need a more advanced printer. I have only had problems with paper jams on a few occasions although it seems to be a big problem for other users. Occasionally when I try to print something, my computer also says the printer is not connected or not powered on although it is. As with all Dell printers, you can only get ink for it by ordering it through Dell. Their ink is very expensive to start with and then I would wind up paying 29.99% interest on it using their Dell card. You would be much better off to get a different brand computer so that you could get cheap ink for it and could also run get it from your local store anytime, instead of waiting for Dell to ship it to you. It has made things pretty easy to handle. My roommate and I have no time to go get pictures developed, or papers copied somewhere else with our busy schedules I sure do have to time writing this review. It has been reliable and also relevant to my life and also my roommates. It is capable of scanning, copying, etc. When you need these features it is a good printer. It does have some issues. Many of the issues are related to the ink. When you replace your ink with expensive Dell ink the printer continuously gives you a low ink warning. Besides, you have to order the ink from Dell and it's very expensive.

Even doing that, the printer still tells you the ink is low. If you want don't mind spending a bundle on ink, and looking at low ink warnings all the time, then this is the printer for you. Nor can I keep buying printers. I'm glad I still have my old Lexmark. If the Dell is dead I'll go back to Lexmark. Anonymous Printer has been sitting dead since. Everything was fine and one day I got that error message out of the blue. I changed cartridges, nothing. I went to the Dell website and they gave instructions for cleaning the print heads. Didn't work. I know there's an easy fix, but haven't found it yet.

I hate these all in one things. They're dinosaurs. Can anybody tell me how to get rid of it. It started when I changed print cartridges. I always ordered directly from Dell and had no trouble but the ones I have now are from Staples. It's my 2nd set from Staples. Took the 1st ones back because they seemed defective. When I go to scan into email it says the all in one driver does not respond. Of course it is just out of warranty. I have unplugged everything several times as well as rebooted several times. Nothing. Help please and thanks. Mine is doing the exact same thing! Unknown. The problem I am having is after changing the ink cartridges something happened and the LCD panel went from the English language to Chinese and I can't figure out how to change it back. I have tried uninstalling and then reinstalling the software. Does anyone know how to fix this? I first had a vague narrow white strip horizontally down the sheet of paper. I had small strips that size that would be cut off sheets of paper when I printed. This didn't happen frequently. Then I got the PAPER JAM MESSAGE. Finally I found that a thin strip of paper was jammed inside the guts of the printer. I pulled it out on two occasions with a tweezer. I took a piece of card stock and gently pushed it through the printer. There are no more paper jams. STILL, I RECEIVE THAT MESSAGE. I phoned Dell, they said, BUY A NEW PRINTER. It printed and worked great until I discovered the very narrow, long strip of paper barely exposed at the bottom of the printer. Now, how do I get rid of the PAPER JAM MESSAGE? I'm getting a cartridge error when I just replaced it. I'm also having problems with it printing and reading memory cards. This whole printer has just given me problems. It's saying my ink refills haven't taken effect either saying both are low to empty after being replaced. I am having the same cartridge error and have replaced the cartridge with OEM and still issue. Anonymous This all started when I was trying to do a watermark.

Help! I've gotten that on my A960. The solution is to uninstall the printer driver and reinstall it fresh. You may need to download a new driver first if you don't have a disk. Hope this helps!
