I was hoping the Scala 700 would be the Scala 500 only better. In some respects it is. Its smaller and lighter, and provides a locate feature which I got to use after I lost it in a large open field. The blue tooth connection helped narrow my search, but that still left 60 or so sqft to comb. The audible buzz, though not very loud, made it easier to find. My main quibble with the set is comfort, its about half the size of the 500, thats good but the ear piece doesnt quite fit the same way. The ear hook is thinner and not as soft.

The unit itself is hard plastic, vs the 500 which had a partial rubber layer that I now miss. Also the button doesnt inspire the feeling of good build quality, it rattles and has an uneven press. Overall its a good product.Excellent sound and volume control.Lots of advanced functionality that is hard to use with out instructions or constant use. If I am in a noisy environment, people sometimes have a hard time hearing me but that is infrequent. I have had some difficulty keeping this working with my Treo 700wx but I have never figured out if it is the cellphone or the Bluetooth headset. The ability to easily switch it from one ear to the other without any hassle is also nice. I am very impressed with the battery life. Ive had this for a month and despite sometimes not charging it for a couple days, I have never run out of juice. Most importantly for me is the comfort. Once I figured out how to adjust the ear band so there are no pressure points, I dont even realize I have it on; thats how light it is. In fact, a couple times it has been on when I laid down in bed at night and I didnt realize it until I rolled over and put that ear on my pillow. Still, Ill take the lightweight headset anytime. If I were to buy a Bluetooth headset as a gift, this would be the one. The body feels overall solid as its a 1piecedesign, but upclose there are elements that feel cheap and plasticky, the large seam in the middle flexes slightly when grasped, the light window flexes in easily, and the control button is a little loose in its travel so it rattles, its slight but when its up on your ear its a noticeable sound. I had no problems at all with the small ear loop, no discomfort and it shaped easily. I dont like having things in my ear canal, so this alternative design was what I was looking for with the larger metalgrillecovered speaker that hovers just outside the ear canal. However, the plastic housing around it isnt rounded enough so a button press jams hard plastic into the side of the ear, a little painful. Static is common here, whether sitting near the computer, laying on my side, or just standing right next to the phone, thered be a little to a moderate amount of static which got frustrating after a while since I thought Bluetooth 2.0 in the headset and my phone is supposed to minimize that. The unit has good distance in my apartment, works through walls, but turns into a static farm when the microwave is running. I also found when I placed it in standby mode near my cordless house phone, that phone picked up a slight distortion. Finally, the thing that damned it in my eyes is sound quality. The speaker is generally loud enough, the mic slightly less so but fairly adequate pickup. People can hear me, and I can hear them, but both the mic and the speaker sound are muffled and have tincan effect. The sound quality is just not there with this one, and thats the whole point of it. EDIT the next person who reviewed this reminded me of another drawback, there is a constant background hiss whenever the unit is active. Other BT headsets Ive tried with this phone havent had that issue. I was disappointed enough to send this back and ask for an exchange after just 3 days, I need better sound quality.

Ive been using the headset for 6 months now, so I think its a good time to give it a fair personal review. Pros 1. Audio is good. Its loud and clear. As a result, I rarely use the wall charger as I always charge it next to my laptop. 3. Therere only 2 buttons on the headsets, one dial and one button. Yes, you HAVE to read the manual, and its even better if you read it several times. 4. Pairing with the RAZR is very easy. Ive never had any issues once paired. 5. The unit is very light and doesnt look bulky at all. 6. Battery life is pretty good. It never runs out almost. The earloop was broken after using it for 5 months. I received response from the company 1 day after I had emailed them. Then 4 days later I got the earloop replacement via USPS. Therere a couple features that may matter to others but not me A. Allow me to search for the headset from the phone.

Havent tried this feature yet as I leave it at the same place at work or home. Being light is one thing, but therere some area where a little details matter. 2. The earloop broke after a free fall from waist level after 5 months of use. Seems like the plastic used on the earloop isnt strong enough. 3. The audio is reset back to default after turning off the headset, and the default volumne of the headset is pretty high. 4. Once you put the headset to mute by holding the dial during conversation, you cant adjust the volume. I found this one of the biggest cons and very annoying. 5. Again, while on mute, the headset reminds you that youre on mute by beeping every 10 or 20 seconds. The beeps are just too long 2 beeps that lasts almost 2 seconds that I miss the conversation from other parties. In case you wonder why it matters, I use the headset to join conference call. 6. The end of USB cable that attaches to the headset is NOT standard miniUSB. It would be so much better to carry just 1 USB cable so that I can charge the RAZR and the headset 7. Like all other BT headsets, static is still a problem. When no static is present, people can still tell Im on cellphone or using BT headset, even Im in a quiet room. And I must say the RAZRs audio and mic quality is pretty darn good. 8. Not easy to adjust the earloop to a comfortable and snuggle position. At a reasonable snuggle and comfortable position, the mic points to my nose instead of my mouth. 9. It fits ok with my glasses, although far from perfect. However I may have to try out others in order to see whether this one is better than the rest. 10. The indicator light blinks even though Im not on a call. Well, I can see why its blinking, just to remind me that the headset is on. Its acceptable, but again I have to work around some of the annoying stuff. Please try again later. Please try again later. At the beginning you might feel that it doesnt sit well on your ear and the speaker doesnt go fully inside your ear so you might think you are actually getting the outside noises into the mix. But after a while, you get the hang of it and you learn how to wear it, bend the loop around your ear which by the way can be easily exchanged from left to right, and sit comfortably on your ear. People

say they hear me clear and very well. I hear them clear as well although the tin can effect is still there, but that really isnt bothering me at all. After all you just need something you can speak into and hear well. And this one does do the job. Some people praise or are hooked on the neat feature of swapping between two phones. At the time they did make a hook attachment for it that would let you hang it from a glasses frame, but I never got it. Another consideration about the earpiece is this do not leave it in a hot car. Albeit beautiful, this is not the only beauty that lies within this headset. The ear loop which is not an optional extra with this headset easily slots into the

designed hole near the front end. By turning the headset on its side, the user can see and use the volume rocker switch, which is cleverly located over the USB charging unit.

Like most Bluetooth headsets, there is the standard LED function light which on this unit, is very large and noticeable. The build quality on the Scala700 leaves something to be desired. Perhaps it's the cost of making a highperformance headset affordable, but compared to some of the other headsets I have tried this one seems to be more thinly constructed. Depending on your viewpoint, you may consider this to be a good thing as it means the Scala700 itself is very light in weight and easy to wear. I didn't think this would be my cup of tea, but having given it a try I did find it to be quite useful. While you may choose never to use the pouch, it is nice to at least have the option! Being quite picky about my settings, I made sure everything was the same as the other headsets I have used in the past. One of the main features that Cardo boasts is this headset can be paired with up to eight phones at anytime, but most importantly can be used with two phones at any time without having to disconnect and reconnect. I was able to leave the headset in the car and allow both mine and my wife's BlackBerry to alternate the usage of the headset by the simple double click of the rocker wheel situated on the end of the headset. This function worked extremely well, and was handy to have especially as I find it easier to have the one headset in the car than have several bouncing around. I tried testing it on all 4 BlackBerrys I have in my house and in every case had no luck in getting this function to work. I went through pairing process again and again hoping it would start to work but to no avail. On occasions when trying to turn the volume up, the wheel rocker would in effect be upside down, but having learnt most of the functions on the headset, I was able to reverse this function allowing the user to happily wear the Scala700 on either ear. I would point out though, if you power the headset down, you would need to reset this function.
