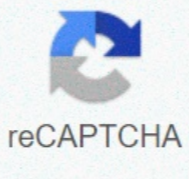

## How to add border in word online

You can use them to insert a tough rule under the text for decoration or emphasis, create a contour box around the text or pictures or use them to frame cells in a table. The border command of the word gives you the flexibility to choose the edge position, line thickness and line style. Line styles can be continuous, multiple lines together or dotted lines. Open the Microsoft Word application by selecting it from the Start menu or double-clicking the program icon. Type some text in the document window. Press the "RETURN / ENTER" button to move to a new line. Click on the "Home" tab and locate the "Bordi" command icon on the "Design" panel in the middle of the tape through the top of the screen. The icon looks like a weak crosshairs outlined with a thin and black square. Click on the "Bordi" icon to expand the drop-down menu of the onboard options. Choose a horizontal line and it will appear through the width of your page. Click and drag to select a text paragraph on the page, and then click the "Bords" icon and choose a box-style border from the drop-down list. Now a box will appear around the selected text. You can apply a box-style border to one word, several words, a paragraph or multiple paragraphs, depending on what you highlight before using the command. Click on the "Bordi" icon to access the drop-down menu again, and then select the last command in the menu, "Bords and Shading". This brings a dialog box that allows you to customize your edge with line styles, line widths and color choices. You can also add a border to the document using the automatic format of Microsoft Word as typing the function. This function allows you to type the symbols of quick choice that become edges when pressing the "RETURN / ENTER" button or the space bar after the symbols. For example, type "-" (without quotes) for a single line solid board, type "=" for a double-line or "#####" edge for a triple-line edge. In the Macintosh version of Microsoft Word and Word versions for Windows before 2007, use the "Formed" menu to access commands and border functions. For the 2014 version of Word and Onwards, use the "Design" tab on the left to navigate towards the border controls, which will appear right. The width of a horizontal edge adheres to the return guides on the ruler. To make the edge longer or shorter, click and drag the triangular markers of return to the top ruler to the left or right. If you accidentally add a formatted board to the document and do not want it, press the "Near" button on the Quick Access Toolbar at the top left of the screen or press the "Ctrl" + "Z" keys on the Keyboard to undo the formatting.
