THE RIFIC Scroll down to see the list of sports stars Emma Hawkins, Sports ReporterPublished: 6:30, 16 May 2025GOLF superstar Rory McIlroy now has a net worth of £260million following his incredible Masters win.The 36-year-old ended his long wait for a Masters title last month following a tense playoff with Justin Rose.5.Rory McIlroy is now ranked as the top British sports star in the Sunday Times Wealthiest 40 Under 40 Rich List and 19th overall.The sports star with the next-highest net worth is Anthony Joshua on £195m, ranked 24th on the list.Tennis legend Sir Andy Murray is placed 35th in the overall rankings with a worth of £110m.And just below him in 38th is England captain and Bayern Munich striker Harry Kane, who is valued at £106m.They are the only British sports stars on the Rich List.Also included are the likes of Daniel Radcliffe, Dua Lipa, Adele, Harry Styles, Ed Sheeran and Cymruark CEO Ben Francis.CASINO SPECIAL – BEST CASINO BONUSES FROM 1111 DEPOSITS.Dimitry Bukharin, the owner of video game company Playrix, tops the list with a net worth of £12.2bn.Sir Lewis Hamilton topped the table last year but did not qualify this time around after turning 40 in January. Yes, please. Getty Images Someone's going to put on a green jacket on Sunday at the 2021 Masters, but that same golfer will also be winning the biggest golf tournament in the world.Augusta National released its payout breakdown for the 2021 Masters, and the total prize and payout breakdown is the same as it was for the 2021 November Masters, which Dustin Johnson won.The total purse is \$11.5 million, with the winner getting \$2.07 million. Second place takes home \$1.242 million. Rounding out the top five: third place receives \$762,000, fourth gets \$552,000, and fifth brings home \$460,000.The complete Masters payout breakdown for the top 50 is below. There's a green jacket that comes with it too, of course. But the prestige of being crowned champion during the season's first major at prestigious Augusta National Golf Club lasts forever, and the lifetime exemption to play in the Masters each year winner earns just a lot of money at stake for the contenders this weekend. The Masters announced Saturday that this year's purse will be \$21 million, with the winner on Sunday earning \$4.2 million. That's an increase from last year's record amount of \$20 million, when there was a total payout of \$28 million for the golfers that made the cut and defending Masters champion Scottie Scheffler earned \$3.6 million for winning his second green jacket. Here's a breakdown of how this year's Masters purse will be doled out when the final round concludes on Sunday, as well as what the payouts and prize money have been in previous years at Augusta National Golf Club. He'll also get to put plenty of greens in his pockets. The purse for this year's tournament, which is the same as in 2024, is one of the largest on the PGA Tour, meaning the payouts for top finishers are going to be sizable. Last year's champion, Scottie Scheffler, took home \$3.6 million, and other golfers inside the top-five and beyond had a decent payday themselves. Some household names will be looking to add to their ledgers with a strong showing at this year's Masters. Rory McIlroy has won twice already in 2025 and secured more than \$9 million. Hideki Matsuyama, the 2022 Masters champion, won The Sentry and has made more than \$4 million. But every golfer would love to bring home a seven-figure check from Augusta National. It is a \$2 million increase from 2023 and a \$5 million increase from 2022.While the Masters is the most prestigious tournament on the PGA Tour, it is not the one with the largest payout. That distinction belongs to The Players Championship, which this year had a purse of \$25 million. McIlroy took home \$4.5 million as the event winner.MORE: Masters te times, putings and featured group:How much money does the Masters winner get?The winner of the 2025 Masters will take home \$3.6 million, which is 18% of the total purse. That's the same as what Scottie Scheffler won last year, and slightly more than what Jon Rahm won in 2023, when he pocketed \$3.24 million. The runner-up at this year's Masters will receive \$2.1 million and the third-place finisher will have a \$1.3 million payout.MORE: Everything to know about the 2025 MastersMasters Tournament payoutsThe event at the Masters, the prize money awarded to each of those players is the evenly divided amount of the total money they would have been awarded had they all finished separately. For example, if Jordan Spieth, Justin Thomas and Collin Morikawa all finished tied for second, the money for second (\$2,160,000), third (\$1,356,000) and fourth place (\$960,000) would be added together and divided by three, paying each player \$1,492,000.
