The students would listen to words you would say, and they would write them according to their exact spelling. This is a test to demonstrate the ability of a child to spell vague words orally. This will be given by the teacher only to students with the most potential spelling ability. The teacher will call out the word, and the student must spell it out loud before making a mark on their test paper. After all words in one test have been read, another test can be started or if time is short, then give one test rather than two as some teachers do so that each test is worth 100 percent of a student's grade. The purpose of this exercise is to improve students' proofreading skills. Students read texts with spelling and grammar mistakes and fix the errors as they go along. This is not simply a spelling exercise but rather a practice in reading where students get familiar with common patterns of language, syntax, and general usage.
