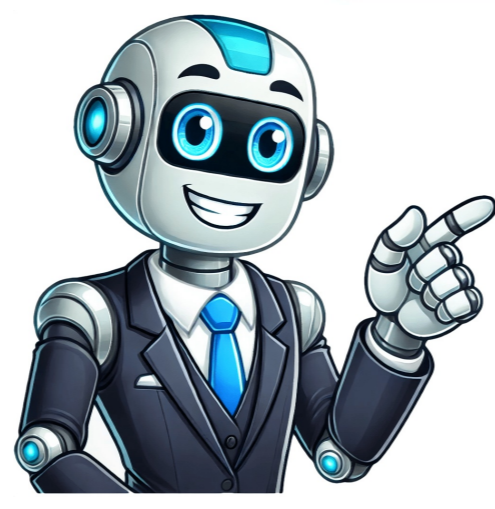

What is uhs test

The University of Health Sciences (UHS) has announced that admissions for 2024 are now open.
