'n Misdaad kan die oortreding van die wet wees. Volgens Westerse regleser, moet daar 'n gesamentlike sameleop van beide actus reus (skuldige handeling) en mens rea (skuldige gewete) wees vir 'n misdaad om pleeg te geword het; behalwe in die geval van streng aanspreeklikheid. As 'n vereiste vir vervolging verg sekere wette 'n bewys van 'n oorsaaklike verband tussen die beskuldigde se handeling en die kriminele oortreding onder oorwinging. Verder vereis sekere wette dat aanleidende omstandighede moes plaasgevind het vir 'n misdaad om pleeg te gewees het. Verder vir 'n misdaad om vervolg te kan word moet corpus delicti (of bewys van 'n misdaad) vasgestel word. Die oortreding van die wet kan ook die voorneme wees om die wet te oortree of om ander in die proses te ondersteun; in sommige stelsels kan die eenvoudige assosiasie vir die organisering van 'n misdaad gestraf word, selfs as die feit nie bevestig is nie en vir baie misdade word die poging daartoe ook gestraf, selfs al is die misdaad nie deurgevoer nie (in Kalifornië kan die straf daarvoor soveel as die helfte wees as vir die misdaad self.[1] Misdaad word beskou as oortredings teenoor die gemeenskap en word as sulks deur die staat gestraf. Hulle kan skoliasties onderskei word afhngende van die passiewe teiken van die misdaad (die slagoffer), of teenoor die geskende belange, as misdade teen: die persoonlikheid van die Staat die regte van 'n burger die openbare administratie die toepassing van geregtigheid die godsdienstige sentiment en die respek vir die dood die openbare orde die openbare vertroue die openbare Ekonomie, nywerheid en handel die openbare sedes die persoon en sy eer die erfenis Misdade kon andersins ook onderskei word na aanleiding van verwante strawwe (en dan op die graad van oortreding wat verbode veroorsaak het), verwyte en oortredings.
Oor die algemeen verstaan die definisie van 'n misdaad, in die meeste westerse stelsels, die voorneme (voluntas nocendi) van die oortreder om dit te doen, daarom word dit gewoonlik nie bestraf wanneer die voorneme nie teenwoordig is nie of wanneer die oortreder nie by sy volle verstand of onder 'n sekere ouderdom is nie. In baie stelsels is die strafregtelike aanspreeklikheid persoonlik, en word turrugwerkende strafreg verbied en kan niemand vervolg word vir 'n misdaad waar die strafreg nie die misdaad as sulks ten tye van die oortreding beskryf het nie. Die definisie van 'n misdaad weerspieël die teenswoordigede heersende houdings in 'n samelewing. Die besit van dwelms was byvoorbeeld nie altyd 'n misdaad nie en tydens die drankverbod era in die V.S.A was alkohol onwettig. Aangeleenthede met betrekking tot kriminele gedrag in 'n samelewing word bestudeer in die veld van sosiologie en die onderafdeling van kriminologie en persone wat die vakgebied bestudeer word kriminoloog genoem. Die geestesstoel en helderheid van gees word deur sielkundiges bepaal, veran in sake waar 'n kranksinnighedsvrewer gebruik word. Die eerste beskawings het regskodes gehad al was dit nie altyd opgeteken nie. He is a former K-1 Heavyweight champion.[5] It's Showtime Heavyweight world champion,[6] and a K-1 World Grand Prix 2008 and 2009 finalist.[7] Nicknamed The Golden Boy, he is regarded as one of the greatest professional kickboxers of all time.[8] Combat Press ranked him as a top ten heavyweight kickboxer between January and November 2016.[9][10] Early life Badr Hari was born and raised in Amsterdam, the capital of the Netherlands. He began kickboxing at the age of seven under the guidance of former World Champion Mousab Akamrane. As a teenager, he trained at the Sitan Gym of Mohammed Aït Hassou. When the Sitan Gym moved to Rotterdam, he joined Chakuriki Gym, run by Thom Harinck.[11] Hari fought under the Dutch flag until he lost to Stefan Leko in 2005. Hari, who tried to publicly address the audience after his defeat, was booed so loudly that he no one could make out his words. He expressed disappointment in the Dutch fans: "I thought to myself, I have never witnessed such ungratefulness". From then on Hari has represented Morocco and stopped working with Harinck. Mike Passenier became his new coach.[12] Kickboxing Early career At the inaugural K-1 Heavyweight Championship at K-1 World GP 2007 in Hawaii on 28 April 2007,2001 Hari began the bout in his usual aggressive manner as he knocked Fujimoto down with a left straight, early on in the round. Hari pressured as the fight resumed and knocked Fujimoto out with a head kick at the 56 second mark of the bout.[21] Four months later, Hari was scheduled to fight a rematch with Peter Graham, in a non-title bout, at K-1 World GP 2007 in Hong Kong on 5 August 2007. Graham won their previous fight, at K-1 World Grand Prix 2006 in Auckland on 5 March 2006, by a third-round knockout. Hari won the rematch by unanimous decision, with scores of 30–27, 30–28 and 30–27.[22] Hari was scheduled to face Doug Viney in a non-title bout at K-1 World GP 2007 in Seoul Final 16 on 29 September 2007. He won the fight by a second-round knockout, dropping Viney with a right cross.[23] Hari was scheduled to face the two-time K-1 Heavyweight World Grand Prix winner Remy Bonjasky at K-1 World GP 2007 Final on 8 December 2007.[24] Bonjasky won the fight by majority decision, thus snapping Hari's six fight winning streak.[25] Following this loss, Hari was scheduled to face the 2000 K-1 World Grand Prix runner-up Ray Sefo in another non-title bout at K-1 World GP 2008 in Yokohama on 13 April 2008.[26] Hari overwhelmed Sefo early on, knocking him down several times enroute to a first-round knockout victory.[27] Hari was scheduled to make the first defense of his K-1 heavyweight title against Glaube Feitosa at K-1 World GP 2008 in Fukuoka on 29 June 2008. He won the fight by a first-round knockout.[28] After making his first title defense, Hari was scheduled to face Domagoj Ostojic at K-1 World GP 2008 in Hawaii on 9 August 2008. Hari won the fight by a first-round knockout.[29] A month later, Hari was scheduled to face the 7–2 Choi Hong-man at K-1 World Grand Prix 2008 in Seoul Final 16 on 27 September 2008. It was Choi's first fight in nine months, as he was forced out of the sport due to a brain tumor.[30] Hari was awarded a technical knockout victory, after Choi's corner threw in the towel.[31] K-1 Heavyweight Grand Prix Hari participated in the 2009 K-1 World Grand Prix, held at K-1 World GP 2009 Final on 6 December 2009. He was scheduled to fight a trilogy match with Ruslan Karaev in the second round of the tournament semifinals. Hari won the fight by unanimous decision, winning by knockout and Hari winning by decision. Hari won their third fight by a first-round knockout.[55] Hari was scheduled to face Arnold Oborotov at GFC Fight Series 2 on October 16, 2014. He won the fight by a first-round body shot knockout.[56] Hari was scheduled to face Ismael Londt at Akhmat Fight Show on August 22, 2015. He won the fight by a third-round technical knockout.[57] Glory Hari vs. Verhoeven I Hari was scheduled to make his Glory debut against the reigning Heavyweight Champion Rico Verhoeven at Glory: Collision on October 12, 2016.[58] Hari appeared to have won the first round, opening a cut on Verhoeven's nose. Verhoeven was more aggressive in the second round and landed knee in the clinch which broke Hari's arm. As Hari was unable to continue fighting, Verhoeven was awarded the technical knockout victory.[59] Hari vs. Gerges On 3 March 2018, Hari fought Gerges. Hari won the fight by unanimous decision, but a year after the fight it was revealed that both fighters had used sports supplements that contained prohibited substances; as a result, both fighters were suspended.[60] Hari failed a drug test prior to Glory 51. Rotterdam, and was issued with a 19-month suspension after tests on samples provided indicated a violation of Netherlands rules regarding prohibited substances for competitive athletes. Gerges, who faced Hari at the event, was also issued with an official reprimand.[61][62][63] Hari vs. Verhoeven II Hari was scheduled to challenge Rico Verhoeven for the Glory Heavyweight Championship in his first post-suspension fight. The bout was set for Glory 74: Arnhem on 21 December 2019. In the sold-out Gelredome, in front of 30 000 fans, Verhoeven won the fight by a third-round technical knockout. Hari once again found early success, knocking Verhoeven down in both the first and third rounds. Early on in the third round however, Hari suffered a broken ankle from a missed kick, once again rendering him unable to continue competing.[64] Aside from selling out the arena, the rematch also drew 3.5 million viewers, an estimated 53% of the live television audience in the Netherlands, which was the second highest viewership of a live sports broadcast in Dutch television history.[65] Hari vs. Adeguyi On 19 December 2020, Hari fought the #2 ranked Glory heavyweight contender, Benjamin Adeguyi in a Glory Heavyweight Championship Fight at Glory 76. The fight was originally planned to take place on 20 June, but was postponed multiple times due to the COVID-19 pandemic.[66][67] On 13 September, Glory announced the event would take place on 7 November.[68] only for it to be postponed again, when Hari announced that he tested positive for COVID-19 on 19 October.[69] Hari lost the fight by KO in the third round after being kicked by Adeguyi.[70] Glory vice-chairman Scott Rudmann revealed the following day that Hari suffered a double break in his nose on knockout.[71] Hari vs. Wrzosek It was announced on 31 May 2021, that Hari would face the #8 ranked Glory heavyweight contender Arkadiusz Wrzosek. The bout was scheduled as the main event of Glory 78: Arnhem, held on 4 September 2021.[72] Hari had a great start to the bout and managed to knock Wrzosek down three times with body shots before the midway point of the fight. Halfway through the second round however, Wrzosek landed a head kick which knocked Hari out, extending his winless streak to five fights.[73] Personal life Relationships and children Hari is married to Daphne Romani and has four daughters and a son.[74] The family currently lives in Morocco.[75] Legal issues Hari has been arrested multiple times since 2006 on various assault charges,[76] and gained a reputation for violent behavior:[77] a psychologist who spoke to Hari in relation to one of his trials concluded that his success as an athlete and celebrity status, combined with a lack of personal guidance, resulted in narcissistic personality traits.[78] About his violent eruptions, Hari has said: "I am able to explode at any moment. [...] When my brakes are off, it's just one big clump of explosion, chaos and noise, and I become blind to it all. [...] A storm, a hurricane, a disaster. [...] There just is a certain aggression inside of me, of which I don't know what to do with and neither does it come from." [79] At his conviction on 21 February 2014, the district attorney described Hari as an individual who is very short-tempered, indulges in vulgar power display, and demonstrates aggressive behavior in hotels, restaurants and café establishments, or contact with witnesses, with the exception of his girlfriend Estelle Cruifff.[80] The day following his release he was spotted violating this condition by eating out at a deli with Cruiff. He also made contact with two witnesses of the incident.[89] As a result, Hari was arrested again by police in Amsterdam and was sentenced to be detained again, this time for three months, with his eventual release in January 2013.[88][89] On 21 January 2013 a court in Amsterdam determined that Hari should again be released from his pre-trial detention, this time with the condition that he could not visit catering establishments between the hours of 8:00 PM and 8:00 AM.[90] By this point the main witnesses in the case had been heard; and the court deemed it unnecessary to further detain Hari.[90] After Hari's release he resumed training with the intention of returning to the ring.[91] His trial was reportedly set to take place in March 2013.[92] On 21 February 2014 the district court in Amsterdam sentenced him to prison for 1+1/2 years.[93] His legal team and the prosecution filed an immediate appeal.[94] The Court of Appeal found him guilty of aggravated assault, noting in particular that each of his assaults was preceded by a relatively mild quarrel and that to his victims his violent behaviour came as a complete surprise, leaving them no chance to defend themselves. He was sentenced to two years in prison, of which ten months were suspended. Since he had already spent eight months in pre-arrest, he still had to serve half a year in prison.
