The source for any answer you need How are prices calculated? Prices are based on the weight, volume, service and destination of your shipment. Consignments may also attract surcharges for additional services. Where can I find the shipment (consignment) on my invoice? The 9-digit shipment number (also called waybill or consignment number) is located on the left side of the invoice, about 3cm below the customer number. Can you tell me when my shipment will be delivered? To find out if your shipment has been delivered, who signed for it and other tracking information just type in your TNT consignment number on the Track & Trace page. What is the volumetric weight and how is this calculated? We calculate both the actual physical weight and the volumetric weight of your shipment. The higher of the two determines the price. To determine volumetric weight, first calculate the volume of your package and then multiply this figure by the relevant conversion factor. See Calculating Volumetric Weight for details. What is a commercial invoice? Shipments that travel outside the European Union must be accompanied by a commercial invoice. Some items are considered documents and may not require a commercial invoice. Which goods are considered dangerous or hazardous goods? To be able to make calls, send texts and use mobile data services with the SIM card, it must be registered as soon as it is inserted into a device. Register Existing TNT SIM All current TNT SIM subscribers should remember that they must register their SIMs before April 26, 2023. Otherwise, the SIM card will be deactivated and rendered unable to send messages, make calls, or access the internet. In case of a failure to meet the deadline, a five-day grace period will be granted to complete the registration, which may be extended for up to 120 days by the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT). How many SIM cards can be registered under a single subscriber? There is no limit on the number of SIM cards that may be registered under a user's name. How to register TNT SIM if a user is a minor? SIMs for minors (below 18 years old) shall be registered under the name of the parent or legal guardian. To register the SIM, they will be required to present an ID card and the consent of their parent or guardian. How to transfer the ownership of a TNT SIM card? You can visit the nearest Smart Store to file a transfer of ownership. What are the additional requirements for TNT SIM for business? For businesses and organizations to use TNT SIMs, the following information is required: Business name Business address Full name of authorized signatory Moreover, businesses will be required to submit the following documents: Certificate of Registration (SEC or DTI) In the case of corporations, a duly adopted board resolution designating the authorized representative, and in the case of other juridical entities, a special power of attorney If you just recently transferred or switched to Talk 'N Text through Mobile Number Portability, you should register your SIM again via the online portal. I am currently abroad but using a TNT SIM. Do I still have to register? If you are traveling abroad and using Smart's roaming service, you need to register your SIM through the telco's online registration portal to avoid deactivation. What are the requirements to register TNT SIM as a foreigner in the Philippines? Foreigners will be required to submit the following documents: Required documents for foreign nationals visiting as tourists: Passport (copy of the page where the visa is stamped) Proof of address in the Philippines (like booking in a hotel or another type of accommodation) Return Ticket to country of origin or any other ticket indicating the date and time of departure from the Philippines Required documents for foreign nationals with other types of visas: Passport (copy of the page where the type of visa is shown) Proof of address in the Philippines Other relevant document, whichever is applicable: (1) Alien Employment Permit by DOLE; (2) Alien Certificate of Registration Identification Card (ACR I-Card) by Bureau of Immigration or other types of official ID card issued by any other visa-issuing agency; (3) School registration and ID for students; (4) Type of travel or admission document validity issued by the DOJ for Persons of Concern (POC) Note that the validity of SIM cards issued to tourists is only 30 days, after which they will be deactivated. It can only be extended upon the presentation of an approved visa extension. Meanwhile, foreigners with other types of visas can obtain SIMs without the 30-day restriction. What will I do if I lose my mobile phone or device with my registered Talk 'N Text SIM card? If you lose your mobile device with your registered SIM card, contact TNT and provide your full name, address, birthday, and mobile number. You can contact Talk 'N Text through their official Facebook page, or you can report it to the nearest Smart Store. Your lost TNT SIM will be permanently deactivated for your safety, and you will receive a new SIM with the same mobile number. What if I register my SIM with false information and a fake ID card? Individuals who submit fraudulent information or fake IDs during the SIM card registration process will face six months to two years in prison or a fine between PHP 100,000 and PHP 300,000, or both. What should I do if I experience glitches, errors, or problems during SIM registration?
