You can take driving lessons before you pass the theoretical test, even if you cannot book the practical test until you have a valid theoretical certificate. It is a good idea to prepare for the driving theory test as you gain experience at the wheel. This will allow you to develop skills for your practical test based on your theoretical knowledge. If you want to pass both tests at the first time of your request, you must have a good knowledge of the guide. The theoretical driving examination consists of two separate sections, which must be completed on the same day. The first part consists of 50 multiple response questions and the second is a video-based risk perception test. You have to pass both sides to pass the theoretical test. In case of failure, you will have to repeat the test on another occasion. Both tests are computerized and must be carried out in a theoretical test center. More information about both tests is shown below. The first part of the driving theory test consists of 50 multiple response questions, five of which are based on case studies. Each question has four options to choose from, of which only one is correct. You need to select the answer by using the mouse to click the chosen option. Before starting the driving theory test, you have the opportunity to do a practice session lasting about 15 minutes. This will help you get used to the navigation system and the question format. The staff of the theoretical testing center will be at your disposal to help you and advise you in case of problems. The multiple choice section is a time test, with a limit of 57 minutes to answer all questions. Each question appears on the screen one at a time and you can go back to any of the questions to check or edit your answers. You need to score 43 out of 50 points to pass the test. The questions are based on knowledge and are randomly chosen by a bank of about 900 questions, divided into 14 categories, covering all aspects of the guide. These categories are: See below for a basic screenshot of the layout that will be presented to you during the test: In this particular example of visual question, you have to click on the image you think is correct. The written questions will have four options, and you need to click the box next to the answer you think right. If you change your mind, click on the image or box again and choose another answer. Even if you have a time limit for multiple choice testing, you should read the test carefully before choosing your reply. You should be aware of the fact that some questions may take more time than others to answer, but I assure you that there are no "tricks.â € à €". Tricks.â € » If you try to switch to the next question without selecting an answer, you will be notified before you can proceed, the remaining time will be displayed on the screen and you will be notified when five minutes are missing at the end of the test. In case of special needs, additional time may be granted, but it is necessary to inform the dvsa in advance. some questions may include a diagram or a photograph; Make sure you carefully study the related question if this is the case. Before you examine the available options, it might be a good idea to think about possible answers and, of course, if any of the available options corresponds to your original thought, you can select the answer safely. five of the 50 multiple response questions will be based on a case study. These questions will appear at the end of the multiple choice section of the driving theory test. the case study is designed to test your ability to apply your theoretical knowledge and understanding of driving to a real situation. This is done by creating a set of circumstances or scenario that you can encounter during the driving, followed by some questions related to the accident, which assesses how it would react in each situation. the sample case study below shows how case study questions can appear in your live test, so you know what to expect. As you can see, the question about the case study is displayed on the left side of the screen and the multiple answer question on the right side. a useful feature of the driving theory test is the ability to report any question you are not sure about. this allows you to return to the question at a later time, in the time that allows it, and to change the answer if necessary. If you arrive at the end of the test before the time expires, you can use the revision option to check your answers. The illustration below shows what information will be displayed in the review screen, including the number of questions you have answered and if you have reported further questions for further details. If you are sure of your answers, you can finish the session before the time expires by pressing the end button. After finishing multiple response questions, there is an optional interruption of up to three minutes before starting the "Perception of Hazards" section of the theoretical test, during which you cannot leave your place. This part of the test provides the vision of a series of video clips (cgl) generated by the computer, during which one expects to identify a development risk. to learn more about the hazard perception test here. at the end of the driving theory test, you will be asked to leave the room where you can expect to receive your result within 10 minutes. for each part of the test (multiple choice part and partthe perception of danger) will be given a score and a list of categories for which the answer to a question may be incorrect. Unfortunately, you will not be informed of which questions you answered incorrectly, the category to which they refer. If you fail one of the sections, you will have to repeat the test on another occasion. Please note that the questions will be different next time you do the test. Once you pass the theoretical test, you will be given a certificate that you will have to submit during the practical test, so keep it safe. The document is valid only for two years from the date of the theoretical driving test, so it is necessary to take the practical test within that period. If not, you will need to support and pass both sections of the theoretical test again before you can book your study. You can book your theory test online or by phone. «To book online, go to www.gov.uk/book-theory-test and register your data. You will need: DVLA license number or DVA credit or debit card to pay the fee an e-mail address to receive confirmation of the reservation If you are in Northern Ireland, click here to book the test. Once you have booked the test, the day itself you will receive an appointment email with the confirmation of the test date and the reference number of the reservation. Telephone «To book by phone, you must call 0300 200 1122 (0845 600 6700 for Northern Ireland), or if we speak Welsh, call 0300 200 1133. The telephone lines are open from Monday to Friday, from 8 to 16. If you have word or hearing problems and use a minicom machine, call 0300 200 1166. If you book by phone and do not have an email address, you will receive an appointment letter within ten days. To cancel or postpone the theoretical examination of the guide, you can do so online by visiting the website www.gov.uk/cancel-theory-test or by contacting the DVSA by phone at 0300 200 1122. This must be done at least three working days before the test date or you may lose the quota. Sundays and public holidays are not considered working days. Cancellation with short notice is permitted only in the following cases: In case of illness or injury and possession of a medical certificate in support of this In case of mourning In case of overcoming school examinations. Under these circumstances, you can resume the test at no additional cost; no refunds are allowed. All candidates for the UK driving theory test must take the test in English or Welsh; voice-over is not allowed in other languages. You're not allowed to bring a translator with you in any case. In Wales and in the theoretical testing centers located at the borders of Wales, it is possible to support theoretician test with Welsh text on the screen. On request it is also possible to provide a voice out of field in Welsh. When booking the test, you must inform the DVSA if you have difficulty reading, health problems or disability. Every effort will be made to welcome all candidates. Difficulty off you have reading difficulties or dyslexia, there is an English voiceover available on a headset to help you. If necessary, you can request up to twice the standard term Complete the multiple response questions section of the test. You will be asked to confirm your difficulties by sending a literature of an independent person who knows your reading capabilities. It could be a teacher or employer. Tips can be requested at the DVSA line for theoretical tests at 0300 200 1122. Auditory difficulties: If you are deaf or have other hearing difficulties, multiple response applications can be delivered to the English language language (BSL). A on-screen signer can also provide the introduction to the danger perception test. On request at the time of booking, you can provide a BSL, speaker or petitioner interpreter. If you have other difficulties or requirements, please call the theoretical test request line for further information. Physical disabilities: if you have a physical disability that would make you difficult to use a touch-screen system or a mouse button during the theoretical test, you need to notify the DVSA at the time of booking, as it may take special agreements for the Completion of the test with a different method. You will have to bring your license driving license with you to the theoretical test. If your license comes from Northern Ireland, you will have to bring your paper counterpart in addition to the driving license with a carto. If you have an old paper driving license, you must also carry a valid passport. If you have lost your license, you need to request a replacement, which could take up to 15 days to arrive. You may need to change the date of the appointment for the theoretical test if it does not arrive in time. Make sure you get to the test center with free time, as it may not be allowed to support the theoretical driving test if you arrive after the start of the session. Once in the center, the staff will verify your license and will make sure you're doing the right category of theoretical tests. Please note that you cannot bring any personal object in the test room and you will need to store cell phones, watches, headphones and bags in a locker. There have been many cases of cheating in theoretical test centers in the past, so a staff member could ask you if you have something you should not have with you.
