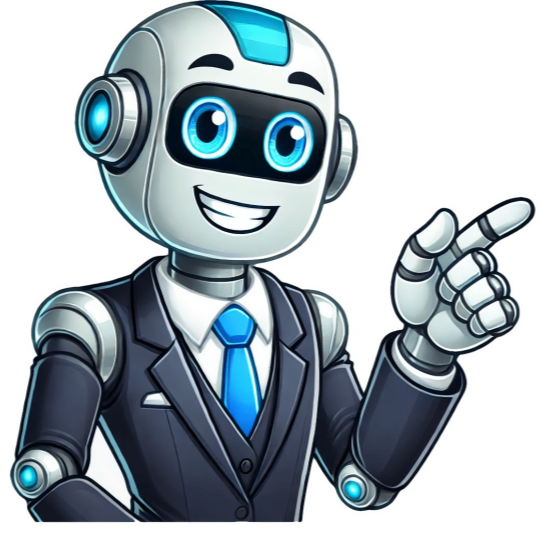

To combat this issue, the KTTA has prioritized collecting, testing, processing, and distributing blood and blood products across all hospitals in the country. Individuals can visit one of the six regional blood transfusion centres located in Nairobi, Embu, Nakuru, Eldoret, Kisumu, or Mombasa. Satellite centres are also available in 21 county hospitals, making it more accessible to donate blood. Each centre has a designated contact number for those interested in donating.
