How to add tackle to rod stardew valley switch

I have looked up videos and tried to put together how to make it work. I have tried with different fishing rods, using ones I found or bought. I suck at fishing so I have stayed with the training rod because its easier to use. I want to level up my fishing and get the Community Center Finish but I can't catch many fish without any bait. Or just getting trash. This is what I do on my switch, I go into my inventory and select my bait and try to click on the rod. It won't do anything and I tried clicking other buttons. But it either switches back and forth between the rod and the bait or it doesn't do anything. I don't know if I'm being dumb and just not doing it right or not using the right rod but I can't get bait on any of the rods I bought, or found. If someone can please help or look into why I can't add bait it would help so much! Thank you!!! Last edited by a moderator: Jan 24, 2021 On the fiberglass rod or better, there is a clear spot for bait when hovered over. I'm not sure how on switch, but on PC you right click the rod with the bait and it's equipped. You can't add bait to the training rod. To the fiberglass rod, you can add bait. To the iridium rod, you can add bait and tackle. Try fishing where the water bubbles, that kinda acts like bait so you'll have quicker catches even without bait. Hey there. I've been taking a break for a while but since the update launched I've been trying to get back into the game and I am encountering the same problem to the point where I wonder whether this is a bug that comes with the fishing rod itself (fiber in my case) or the newest update because I remember this clearly working when I first played last year. A google search claimed the button to combine the bait with the fishing rod should be X which does nothing. A triggers the before-mentioned "switching". While the Fishing Rod is selected it is not possible to switch to a manual movement of the "mouse key" (usually done with the right joycon stick), the mouse-key is just "stuck" on the rod and will not select the empty slot for the bait. Changing the Gameplay setting to "enable 'mouse control' at all times" also doesn't help. /edit: Addendum: bait strictly only refers to bait, not the gadgets, they occupy a different slot and the fiber-rod only support bait-only. So that was the issue, it's been a while xD Last edited: Apr 25, 2021 I have a switch and a novice. I go to the first tab that shows what clothes you have. You hit the A button to select the bait, then hover over the fishing pole and hit Y. But, one must have the iridium rod. And I highly recommend. I had a horrible time fishing for a long time, and that rod really helped. Different tackle can help make fishing easier too. You can also select in your inventory with A and put it on your rod with Y. How to apply spinner to a rod? Tackle (such as the spinner) can only be used with the Iridium Pole. Hover over the rod to make sure the tackle slot is empty. Left click spinner then right click pole with spinner. How do you put a bobber on a fishing line on a Stardew Valley switch? To attach tackle to an Iridium Rod, left-click on the tackle, then right-click on the Iridium Rod. To remove Tackle, first right-click to remove any bait, then right-click to remove the tackle.... Fishing Tackle can be attached to fishing rods to change different mechanics while fishing. You must have an Iridium Rod to equip tackle. To attach the tackle to the rod, right-click on the tackle first and then right-click the Iridium Rod. Remove tackle by right-clicking the rod. Can you attach bait to a bamboo pole Stardew Valley? Bait cannot be used with the Bamboo Pole. Only the Fiberglass Rod (unlocked at Fishing skill level 2) or the Iridium Rod (unlocked at Fishing skill level 6) can use bait. Use in the water to catch fish. 1,800g upon reaching level 2 Fishing. It allows for the use of bait while fishing. How do you lure a Stardew fishing pole? To attach bait or tackle to an Iridium Rod, open your inventory screen, click on the tackle or bait (left-click or right-click, depending on how many you want to pick up), and then right-click on the rod. To remove bait, right-click on the rod. How do I level up my Stardew fishing? Fishing Skill is increased by catching Fish, Trash, Seaweed, Green Algae, or White Algae with a Fishing Rod/Pole or by harvesting Crab Pots. Each level grants +1 Fishing Rod Proficiency, increases the minimum fish size (in/cm) and bobber bar height, and decreases the max amount of time before fish bite. Is fisher or trapper better? If you pick Fisher, fish are worth 25% more. Trapper just gives reduces the resources required to craft crab pots. Fisher makes both fish caught on a rod and in a crab pot worth 25% more. A fiberglass fishing rod with bait equipped. The pole technically has a slot for the bait, which is easy to miss. Using bait and tackle can be a bit confusing for players new to Stardew Valley's fishing system. Here's a quick summary of how it's done, and what they do for you when fishing. If you need help with how to fish, click here. Bait First know that the Bamboo fishing pole has no slots available for bait nor tackle. The better rods have these features. The ability to use bait comes with Level 2 Fishing, as it will make Will sell the Fiberglass fishing pole at his shop by the beach for 1,800G (you should receive a letter indicating he has it available). You can also buy bait cheap there, though level 2 fishing teaches you to craft your own. How to Use Fishing BaitTo use bait, highlight the bait in your inventory, then pick it up as though you're going to move it. Now go to the fishing pole and right-click. The bait will now be equipped to the pole. With an Xbox controller you select it with 'A' and equip it to the fishing pole with 'X'. You can remove the bait by right-clicking or pressing 'X' a second time. You can attach a whole stack of bait so you only need to do this every now and then. Having bait equipped to a fishing pole will increase the speed at which fish 'bite'. This means less time sitting around, and more time reeling in the fish. It greatly increases your profit per day from fishing. Whether you catch the fish or not, you'll use up one of your bait. Tackle How to Use TackleTackle (spinners, barbed hooks, and bobbers) is equipped the same way. Pick up the tackle in your inventory, go over the fishing rod then right click or press 'X' on the Xbox controller to attach it to the pole. Tackle is only available from Fishing level 6 onward and requires you to buy the Iridium Fishing Rod, which has slots for both bait and tackle. Tackle has the largest effect on your ability to catch rare fish. Unlike bait, which decreases in quantity with each use, tackle has durability. Different types of tackle do different things: Spinner (Fishing Level 6) - Increases the rate that fish will bite. Lead Bobber (Fishing Level 6) - Stops the bar bouncing when it hits the bottom of the frame during the fishing minigame. Not useful very often. Trap Bobber (Fishing Level 6) - Makes the fishing minigame bar drop slower, meaning you don't have to click as fast to keep it steady on one level. One of the best. Cork Bobber (Fishing Level 7) - Increases the size of the bar in the fishing minigame by a bit, varies depending on your fishing level. Others are better. Remember, more fishing levels increases the size of the bar as well! Treasure hunter (Fishing Level 7) - Increases the chance of treasure chests appearing by 1/3 (meaning 20% total chance). Great for finding artifacts. These are crafted for 2 gold bars or bought for 750G from Willy. Dressed Spinner (Fishing Level 8) - Further increases the rate fish will bite. Barbed Hook (Fishing Level 8) - Helps the bar stick to the fish during the fishing minigame, making it easier. Like Stardew Valley's regular bait item, different types of tackle can be bought from Willy's shop as you level up. Naturally, you unlock the ability to craft the majority of these on the same level they become available in the shop, though a few are shop-exclusive. In general it seems better to buy them than to craft them, especially in the case of items like Treasure Hunter tackle unless you're swimming in Gold bars.
